


DASHBOARD - Record Sorting Sequence

A/ Overview

In the Dashboard, you are now allowed to sort the records in multiple data columns by clicking the column headers. For example, to sort the records by Terminal, ETA and then SSL, you can simply click the column header Terminal, ETA and then SSL.
